Minutes

Meeting of the Jurby Parish Commissioners held on Tuesday 22 March 2022 at 7.00pm Parish Hall, Bretney Road, Jurby.

1. The minutes of the last monthly meeting were agreed and signed.

2. Matters arising from last meeting

- i) It was agreed to holdover any discussion on the Sub Post Office pending outcome from Tynwald
- ii) Clerk confirmed Andrew Livesey (AL) had been given authority to progress repairs in play park
- iii) It was noted that there was to be a separate meeting re the Jurby Development Plan at 8:00 pm 22 March.
- iv) Clerk confirmed still no decision on defibrillator planning
- v) Clerk confirmed AL had the new sign for installation
- vi) It was agreed to use areas for Dog Poo byelaws drafted by LJK
- vii) Clerk informed the Board that AL would have plinth for bin complete by end of month (weather permitting)
- viii) Clerk confirmed Expressions of Interest were being received and would all be considered at next meeting
- ix) Clerk confirmed no response from DOI re abandoned vehicles
- x) It was agreed to authorise Andrew to empty Beach Bin once per week xi) Clerk confirmed Pop Up catering would need landowners permission and a licence from DOI
- xii) LQ to arrange new quote for upgrade of BMX track
- xiii) Clerk confirmed that the Commissioners had agreed in principle to adopt the natural play area proposed by Hartford Homes in their new development at Ballagarraghyn, Bretney Rd

- i) Clerk informed the Board that the current provider of hedge cutting, Ben Begbie, did not wish to be considered for the new contract
- ii) Parish Walk notification was received
- iii) Jason Moorhouse response re Sub Post Office noted
- iv) The responses from our two MHK's re Motor Museum and Café were noted v) Clerk to raise a cheque for £50 for Mr Scanlon re electricity for Xmas tree vi) It was agreed to consider Recyclecollect for 23/24 budgets
- vii) It was agreed for LQ to post the details re IOM Youth Tour on Social Media viii) It was agreed to post Dog Fouling message on website and social media explaining that Byelaws are being sought
- ix) The Ukraine refugee situation was discussed. It was agreed that this would be best left to Tynwald
- x) The consultation was Local Authority Elections was noted
