Meeting of the Jurby Parish Commissioners held on Monday 20th June 2022 at 7.30pm Parish Hall, Bretney Road, Jurby.

1. The minutes of the last monthly meeting were agreed and signed.

2. Matters arising from last meeting

- i) It was agreed for Clerk to chase DOI re 4 options for Jurby Development and to copy in MHK's
- ii) JNCI are progressing installing defibrillator
- iii) Clerk to progress Dog Poo byelaws
- iv) Clerk informed Board that contractor expected plinth for wheely bin to be completed this month
- v) KLC proposed that JPC made a 50% contribution to the start of the BMX track repairs totalling £1,500. This was seconded by SJM and carried unanimously
- vi) Clerk updated Board that the path between Bretney Estate and Parade Ground was being worked on by DOI
- vii) Clerk to chase contractor re Play Park Maintenance

- ii) Clerk informed Board that contractor was due to spray weeds before end of month
- iii) NSPB amendment Order noted
- iv) Clerk circulated an email from a resident querying why some parts of hedges on Coast Road had been cut. It was agreed that this was probably landowners.

- vi) Clerk informed Board that he had responded to Tynwald Question re Fixed Penalty notices

- ix) It was noted that the Dog Poo bin at the Museum was overflowing. JPC contractor empties this every two weeks but as no normal rubbish bins currently in area it is used by everyone. Clerk to contact DOI.

- xii) Clerk to peak to Bus Vannin re cleaning bus stops and also decorating
- xiii) The email from police re extending hours of lighting during TT was discussed. It was agreed to refer them to MUA in the first instance

- xv) The Beach access enquiry re child's motorbike was discussed. It was agreed that it was not within the remit of JPC
- xvi) The Board were pleased to hear from Hartford Homes that a further development in Jurby was planned. Clerk to invite Hartford Homes to next meeting
