Minutes

Meeting of the Jurby Parish Commissioners held on Monday 15 May 2023 at 7.00pm Parish Hall, Bretney Road, Jurby.

Apologies:

1. The minutes of the last monthly meeting were agreed and signed.

2. Matters arising from last meeting

- i) Clerk informed the Board that he had asked Brett Thomas (BT) of the DOI to meet with the Board to discuss the outstanding matters. Clerk suggested next Board meeting to BT and was awaiting a response
- ii) Clerk informed the Board that he had scheduled time this month to progress the Dog Poo byelaw application
- iii) The response from Mr Palmer was discussed and the Board asked for more information and clarification. Clerk to contact Mr Palmer
- iv) Clerk to contact other Parishes regarding Play Park provision, suppliers for upgrades and funding sources
- v) Clerk informed the Board that still waiting for confirmation of fees for the Music Licence
- vi) Clerk confirmed that no further information had been received on the possible increase in audit exemption limit
- vii) KLC informed the Board that the Governor's visit to the Parish was in hand
- viii) Clerk to obtain quote for the refurbishment of showers in the Parish Hall
- ix) Clerk informed the Board that he had asked the MUA to meet with the Board to discuss the street lighting maintenance
- x) Clerk informed the Board that he would complete the Public Body climate reporting form
- xi) Clerk informed the Board that BT was the contact at DOI to discuss potential use of Parade Ground for TT 2024. See point (i)
- xii) Clerk informed the Board that he had passed the potential breach of planning to IOMG. Waiting for GDPR form to complete
- xiii) LQ informed the Board that JNCI were working on a plan for the BMX track
- xiv) KLC informed the Board that entries were being received and that the JPC plaque had been prepared and invoice to be passed to Clerk for payment
- xv) LQ informed the Board that JNCI were progressing the provision and storage of football nets

- ii) LJK asked the Clerk to remind the DOI that grass cuttings need collecting and not left to blow around estate. This is a potential Health and Safety issue.
