1. The minutes of the last monthly meeting were agreed and signed.
2. Will Challoner spoke to the Board with regards to his vision of an Indoor Sports Facility for the North of the Island based in Jurby. JPC expressed their support for this and suggested a number of contacts to progress this re Funding and support.
