Minutes of the Meeting of the Jurby Parish Commissioners Held on Tuesday 17 July 2024 at 7.00 pm, Parish Hall, Bretney Road, Jurby.

Apologies:

1. The minutes of the last monthly meeting was agreed and signed.

2. Matters arising from last meeting

- i) KLC informed the Board that no broadcast by Manx Radio, regarding the Bus Vannin section of the last meeting, had been heard. JPC were disappointed that no air time given despite this being requested by Manx Radio. Clerk to follow up with Manx Radio
- ii) Clerk informed the Board that there did not appear to be much progress from the DOI regarding the points made at May meeting. Further discussions in the Private Session regarding funding.
- iii) Clerk informed the Board that the Dog Poo byelaws were still with the AG's office. Only item required from JPC was the JPC logo. Clerk to provide.
- iv) Clerk informed the board that JPC contractor had swept the Parade Ground. Unfortunately more glass has appeared. Clerk to pass to DOI. It was also noted that the grass on the Parade Ground was not being cut. Clerk to pass to DOI.
- v) Clerk confirmed that the FOI complaint had been filed but no response as yet.
- vi) Clerk to obtain Parish map for LJK to map gulleys
- vii) The street lighting maintenance options were discussed by the whole Board. It was agreed for Clerk to circulate more information and to be discussed again next month
- viii) LQ confirmed that the defibrillator was registered with Manx Care. Member of the Parish confirmed that it was checked regularly by Manx Care. LQ confirmed any costs were responsibility of JNCI.
- ix) Clerk confirmed that the hedge in question was on the Bretney side of Parish Hall. It was agreed to confirm to contractor that cutting was required
- x) It was agreed that the Clerk would contact IOMG rates section to ascertain what, if any, help JPC could give in recovering outstanding rates

3. Correspondence

- i) Clerk confirmed that he would attend DEFA Permitted Development Review on August 13 at Peel Town Hall.
- ii) Application for road closures for Super Manx Summer Series - 3rd July , 24th July and 14th August noted
- iii) Clerk informed the Board that he had passed the complaint about the 'pavement' between Summerhill Road and the Cronk to DOI and was awaiting a response. Both local MHK's copied in.
- iv) The Spraying of weeds in the Parish and animal issues was discussed. It was agreed that Clerk would contact DESC to ascertain if they had carried out any spraying around Jurby school.
- v) Goods Vehicle AD&N 48 noted

- vi) The issue reported about Killane layby and salt bin was noted and not a JPC issue
- vii) It was agreed that the Jurby Phase 2 lights were acceptable
- viii) The email regarding Domestic abuse from the Clerks forum was discussed but not a JPC issue
- ix) KLC attended the NCAS public meeting. It was well attended and the facts of the matter were put forward in a concise and accurate manner. The matter now rests with the NCAS Committee and the DOI.

4. Town & Country Planning

- i) No planning applications in month.
- ii) Clerk to instruct contractor to cut all junctions around the Parish and also the Rhendhoo Road for safety reasons

5. Any other business

- i) KLC circulated an email concerning work parties from the IOM Prison undertaking work in the Parishes around the Island. Clerk to follow up with IOMP and ascertain requirements
- ii) Clerk informed the Board that he had been in touch with the Probation Service to see if JPC could be added re any work to be done under community Service Orders
- iii) It was agreed that the Clerk would approach the DOI re traffic calming measures for the Parish. Specifically Bretney Rd and Ballamenagh Rd.
