## **Minutes of the Meeting of the Jurby Parish Commissioners Held on Wednesday 25 September 2024 at 7.00 pm, Parish Hall, Bretney Road, Jurby.**

1. The minutes of the last two monthly meetings were agreed and signed.

### **2. Matters arising from last meeting**

- i) Clerk informed the Board that no progress had been made by DOI re the Jurby Initiative despite numerous chasing emails. Last one copied both local MHK's in. Clerk to follow up.
- ii) Clerk informed the Board that AG's office had provided draft Dog Poo Byelaws. These need to be put out for consultation to the parish and to DEFA.
- iii) Clerk informed the Board that the complaint against the response to FOI on Bus Vannin was rejected. It was agreed to wait and see the results of the consultation.
- iv) As LJK had sent apologies the Gulley Maps are deferred to next meeting.
- v) KLC informed the Board that there had been some negative comments on Ramsey Forum about their UK supplier of street lighting maintenance. Clerk to follow up with Ramsey Board.
- vi) Clerk to arrange a list of o/s rates and circulate before next meeting.
- vii) The DEFA permitted development review was discussed.
- viii) The pavement between Summerhill and the Cronk was discussed. Clerk to discuss with IOM Prison re possible working party for the road from Andreas boundary to Sandygate.
- ix) The Parish hedge trimming was discussed. Clerk to ask contractor to redo the Clenagh Rd and to check the Bretney Rd for Gorse.
- x) It was agreed to ask Andy Ralphs for an update on the Autumn public meetings to discuss the Airport Master plan prior to its completion

### **3. Correspondence**

- i) KLC to clarify Northern Chamber of Commerce Autumnal role outs
- ii) Clerk to obtain quotes for new Xmas tree lights – Angel / star based on 16ft tree
- iii) It was agreed that the NCAS issues to be dealt with by NCAS committee but JPC were not prepared to subsidise the loss of Bride contribution to the site.
- iv) Application for a Temporary Speed Limit - A10 Coast Road - 14.10.24 noted
- v) Marown Civic Service – Sunday 29 September at 11.00 at Marown Parish Church noted and Clerk to send apologies
- vi) The DOI Waste Strategy consultation was discussed and agreed to complete individually

### **4. Town & Country Planning**

- i) The email from a resident regarding the planning application 24/91030/B, Creation of a campsite, was discussed. It was agreed that there was support for this application as positive development in the Parish. The only comment was the access via Summerhill road which is due for resurfacing in next two years.

- ii) KLC informed the Board that the view of the crossing points on the Industrial Estate on access to Ballamenagh Rd were being obstructed by Gorse. Clerk to contact DOI.
