Minutes of the Meeting of the Jurby Parish Commissioners Held on Monday 11 November 2024 at 7.00 pm, Parish Hall, Bretney Road, Jurby.

1. The minutes of the last monthly meeting were agreed and signed.
 - i) It was confirmed that the Fruit and Flower Show could continue to hold their Committee Meetings in the Parish Hall. Storage cabinets to be provided by that Committee could be stored in the Parish Hall. Committee member asked if they could donate to a fund held by JPC for the purpose of Jurby Parish Hall renovation. This was agreed.
 - ii) A resident requested hire of the hall for 1 week in the first week of March 2025 for charitable purposes. To be discussed in private session.

2. Matters arising from last meeting

- i) The various emails from DOI regarding the Jurby Initiative were discussed. It was agreed that the Clerk would email DOI expressing their concern over the continued delays in progressing this.
- ii) It was agreed that the implementation of the Dog Poo Byelaws be deferred. A program of education and reporting to be set up to ascertain if and where any issues lay.
- iii) LQ to provide LJK with map of Parish to allow mapping of gullies
- iv) Street lighting maintenance options deferred to December and January budget meetings
- v) Clerk informed the Board that IOMG rates section had already identified that a significant portion of outstanding rates related to the Industrial Estate and empty units. DOI to transfer funds to clear this. Clerk to ask for updated outstanding rates list.
- vi) Clerk informed the Board that IOM Prison now have a work part working on clearing the weeds between Summerhill Road and The Cronk.
- vii) Clerk confirmed that Cabinet Office have confirmed that the Airport Masterplan is still a working draft but once in a form suitable to be shared JPC will be contacted.
- viii) Northern Chamber of Commerce Autumnal role outs deferred to next meeting
- ix) SJM proposed that new Xmas tree lights be purchased at a cost of £320. This was seconded by DH and carried unanimously
- x) Clerk confirmed that the DOI are cutting the gorse obstructing visibility on Ballamenagh Rd and Industrial Estate
- xi) LQ to circulate suggestions for speed calming measures and then to be forwarded to Clerk

3. Correspondence

- i) Clerk circulate various emails regarding Climate Impact Assessments. These were all noted.

- ii) Clerk circulated an email regarding damage an land at rear of Guardhouse. It was agreed that this was DOI land.
- iii) Jurby Parade Ground Service Reservoir: Tree Felling Licence 588/24 noted
- iv) The Play Park Inspection Report was noted. As the Play Park is being refurbished no further action needed.
