Dear Mr Kennedy,

In your role as Clerk to Jurby Commissioners, I am writing to give you advanced notification that on Sunday 23rd March this year, Hospice Isle of Man will be organising a Half Marathon running race on Closed Roads in and around Ramsey.

The intention of the event is to raise funds for the charity, whilst also providing a significant influx of visitors to the town on the day of the race.

We appreciate that Road Closures may cause inconvenience to some of the local population in the areas it takes place, but please be assured that all reasonable endeavours will be made to ensure as little disruption as possible. Additionally, unlike a Motorsports closure, a Running Road Closure does not have any impact on pedestrians - i.e., the pavements are not closed, and one is permitted to cross the Closed Road itself on foot, at all times, provided it is safe to do so.

The race starts at 0900 on West Quay and all roads and streets in Ramsey town will re-open by 1000, except for the Swingbridge, West Quay between the Swingbridge and Market Place, plus Market Place itself.

Dale Street, Market Hill and Parliament Street will be fully open by 1000 at the latest, and on the wider course outside Ramsey, all roads will be open by 1200 latest.

We hope therefore, there will be no negative impact to any other activities in or around the North, or to your residents. However, if this is incorrect, please do not hesitate to contact me and we will make all reasonable efforts to mitigate.
